


ABOUT COMPANY

DAY 2: YEREVAN-EJMIATSIN

- Visit the museum of the Armenian cognac factory. An excursion is planned to the place where the legendary ARARAT cognacs are born. Guests will acquaint themselves with the history and traditions of creating Armenian cognac. There will be a special reception and tasting of the best-aged cognacs.
- Temple of Zvartnots: sightseeing of the ruins of Zvartnots. Zvartnots Cathedral is a unique architectural structure in Armenia, destroyed 300 years after its construction. You will have the opportunity to stroll through the enchanting surroundings of the temple. Next to the temple, there is also a museum showcasing the history of this magnificent structure
- The Cathedral of Holy Ejmiatsin is a monastic complex, as well as the spiritual and administrative center of the Armenian Apostolic Church, the seat of the throne of the Supreme Patriarch and the Catholicos of All Armenians.

• Retro evening: Back to Soviet Armenia. Here, you can immerse yourself in the atmosphere of Soviet Armenia with its way of life, customs, and history, all presented in one place. You will visit a special museum and see objects and exhibits that tell the story of the country's Soviet past. The visit also includes a themed dinner to enhance your experience.

DAY 3: YEREVAN-GYUMRI, CULTURAL CITY

- Gyumri is the second largest city in Armenia.
- Tour of the Gyumri Museum of National Architecture and Urban Life. As part of the excursion, you will visit the Museum of National Architecture and Urban Life of Gyumri. In the museum, you will immerse yourself in the life and customs of the city of Gyumri, and immerse yourself in the traditional Armenian interior.
- Walking tour in Old Gyumri. Walk through Old Gyumri. The city was under Persian, Turkish, and Russian rule, and bears cultural and architectural traces of the 19th century, which you will see during the tour.
- A master class in arts and crafts. Master class on decorative and applied arts. The blacksmith tradition of Gyumri was included in the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. You will have the opportunity to meet Armenian craftsmen and see how they forge iron, creating examples of works of art and various accessories.
- The Black Fortress of the Russo-Turkish War. Black Fortress during the Russian-Turkish War. If you are familiar with the history of the bloody Russian-Turkish wars, then in Gyumri we will show you their lifeless witnesses.
- Gastro tour: Circassian Valley. Gastrotour in the Circassian Valley. Here you can catch fish with your own hands, and experienced chefs will prepare it according to Armenian recipes.

DAY 5: YEREVAN-GARNI-GEGHARD

- The pagan Temple of Garni, once a place of sun worship, is located in the village of Garni, Kotayk region, on the right bank of the Azat River. It is a unique pre-Christian structure an immovable monument of Armenian history and culture. "Here, you will not only be able to appreciate the temple built in the Greco-Roman style but also enjoy the magnificent view from the river gorge.
- Master class on baking lavash (Armenian bread). In Armenia, the process of baking Armenian bread lavash is very interesting. You will see how Armenian women prepare the dough and place it in a tandoor oven, and the result is delicious bread that you can taste right on the spot.
- Monastery of St. Geghard, partly carved into a nearby mountain. Geghard Monastery is a medieval monastery complex in Armenia. It is located on the right bank of the Azat River in the Kotayk region. The famous spear with which the Roman soldier pierced the body of Christ is kept here. It was brought to Armenia by the Apostle Thaddeus, one of the first preachers of Christianity. The monastery complex of Geghard is a part of UNESCO World Heritage and one of the historical attractions of Armenia. It is impressive how a portion of this monastery complex is integrated into the rock.
- Yerevan Nights: Walking tour in the center of Yerevan. You will see the central square, the Opera House, the famous Yerevan Cascade and feel the warm atmosphere of Yerevan evenings.

DAY 6: TOURS IN THE FORESTS OF ARMENIA

- **Dilijan** is a town in the northern Tavush region of Armenia. Dilijan is an important tourist center. In the center of the community is Sharambeyan Street, which is considered the city's historical center, famous for its unique architecture, workshops, galleries, and museums. Dilijan is also noted as a center for hiking, mountain biking, and resort recreation.
- Monastic complex Haghartsin. There are plenty of ecological routes in Diljan National Park, accompanied by historical and cultural monuments. One of these monuments is the Haghartsin Monastery Complex, which is located 18 km from Dilijan, rising on a hill surrounded by dense forests.
- **Alco tour:** you will visit a small Armenian village nestled in the green and cool forests of Tavush. Upon arrival, you will be warmly welcomed into a village house where homemade fruit vodkas are crafted.
- Lastiver. Walk along Lastiver enjoying wild. Lastiver is a densely forested area where you can explore caves and tree huts. After your alcohol tour, you can unwind and enjoy the cool greenery here.

DAY 7: TBILISI - MTSKHETA

- The historical center of Tbilisi.
- **Sameba** (church of the Holy Trinity), Metekhi (church of the 12th century), Narikala fortress, cable car and sulfur baths area, clock tower near the R. Gabriadze theater
- The ancient capital of Georgia-Mtskheta. The monuments of this small town are included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- Svetitskhoveli Cathedral (XI century) is an ancient religious center of Orthodox Georgia.
- **Jvari** is a tiny picturesque monastery on a high rock at the confluence of the Kura and Aragvi.
- Georgian cuisine and khinkali.

DAY 8: TBILISI – DAVID GAREJI – SIGHNAGHI

- David Gareji Monastery Cave Comple in the Gareji semi-desert.
- Village of Badiauri, where bread is baked in clay ovens "tone."
- **Convent of Bodbe**, built in the 4th century, in honor of the Assumption of the Baptist of Georgia, St. Equal-to-the-Apostles Nino.
- **Sighnaghi** is a city of love on several hills surrounded by a well-preserved double fortress wall of the 17th century.
- Tasting of **Kakhetian** wine.

DAY 9: TBILISI - KAZBEGI

- **Ananuri** a fortress of the 17th century, located 900m above sea level, and belongs to the early feudal era.
- Ski resort Gudauri, beautiful landscape and flora of the alpine zone
- Church of the Holy Trinity in Gergeti, located at the foot of Kazbek and which houses the miraculous icon of the Smolensk Mother of God.
